## MAP & DIRECTIONS FROM DURBAN

GPS CO-ORDINATES: S 31° 67' 27.77" | E 29° 45' 40.72"

When travelling from Durban, you can expect your drive to take about 6 hours over 390km. The conditions of these roads vary and it's best to take it easy and keep a keen eye out for potholes, unmarked speedbumps, cattle, donkeys, taxis and people.

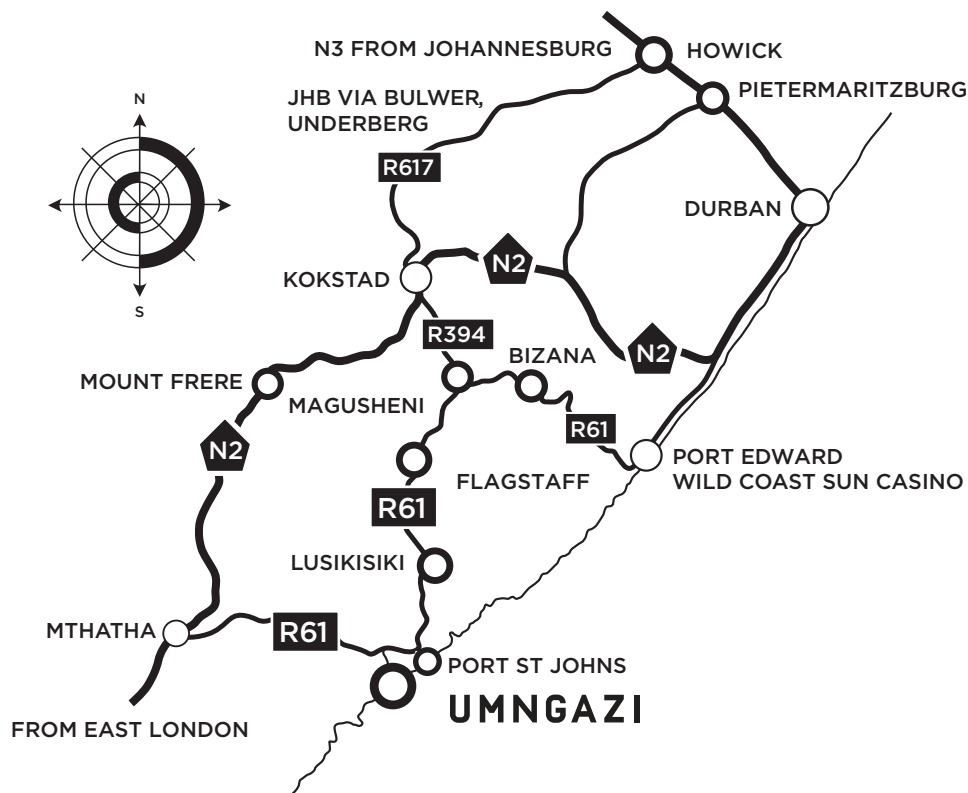
Take the N2 from Durban to Port Shepstone.

From the toll, continue to Port Edward, Bizana, Flagstaff, Lusikisiki and Port St Johns on the R61. **(Don't forget the Flagstaff detour).**

After crossing the Umzimvubu River bridge, turn right, and continue for the next 10km until the Umngazi turn-off. **It is important to note that the last 10km road leading to Umngazi Hotel & Spa is not always in the best condition.** We ask you to please take it slowly and drive carefully on this final stretch, where you will soon be able to relax and unwind in paradise.

### FLAGSTAFF DETOUR:

We recommend taking the detour around the Flagstaff town centre to avoid any unnecessary delays. As you head down the hill on the R61 towards Flagstaff take the right turn before the Flagstaff Shoprite. Follow the road and take the first left. At the top of the road, turn right. Continue on this road until you reach the T-junction with the R61. Turn right and continue on the R61.
